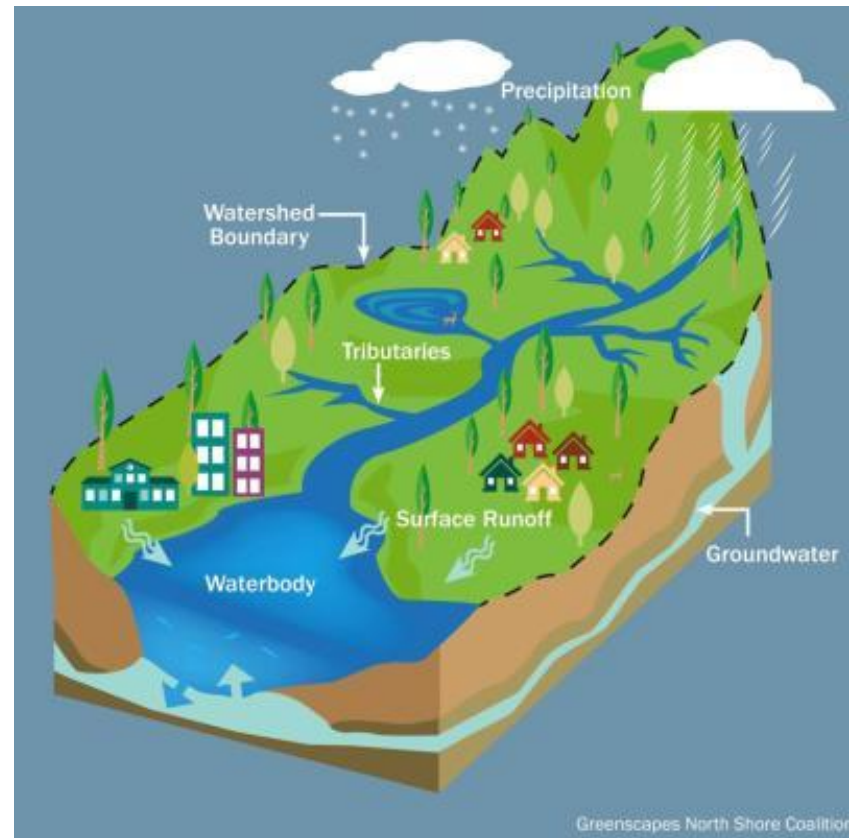

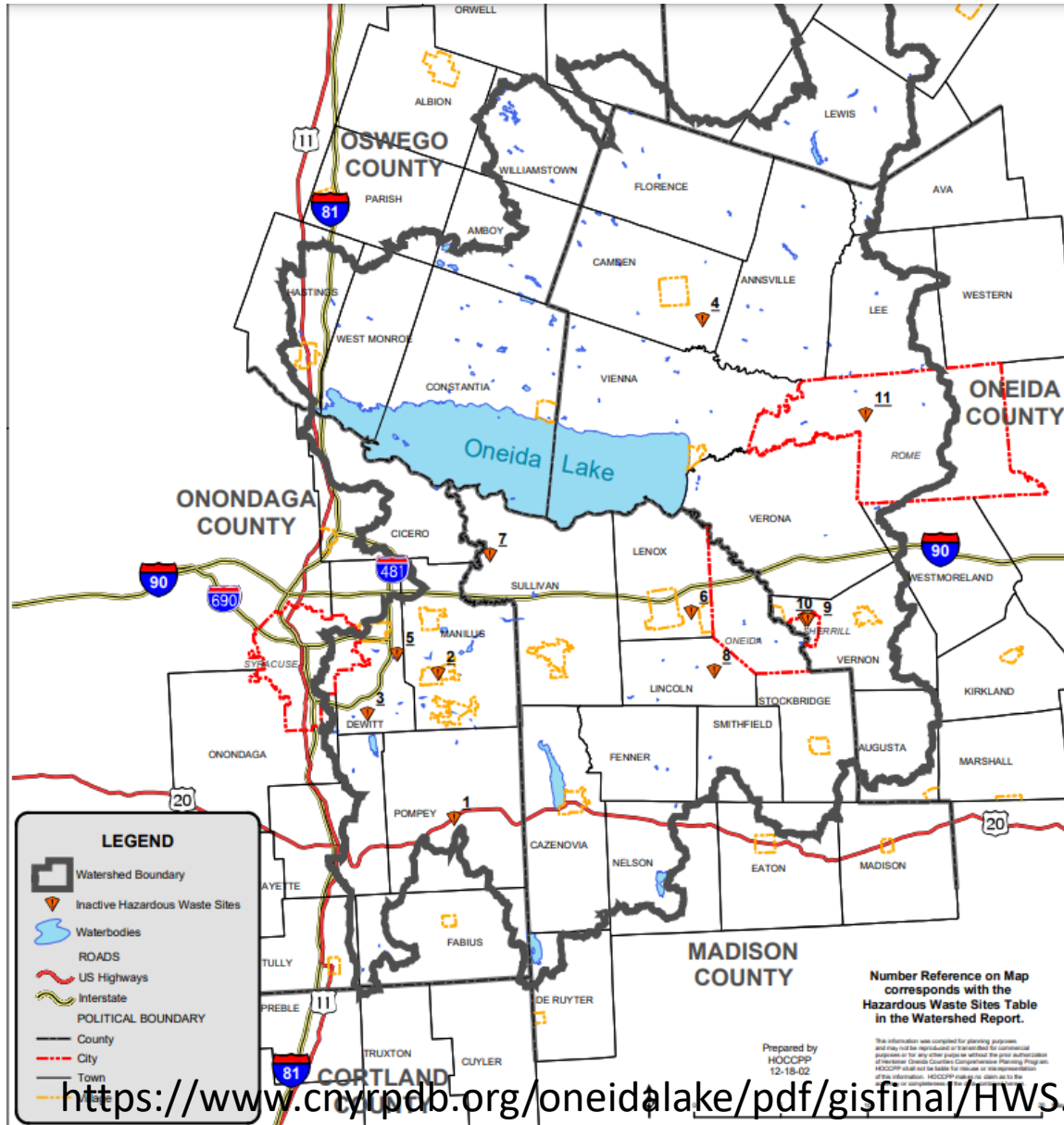
# What is a watershed?

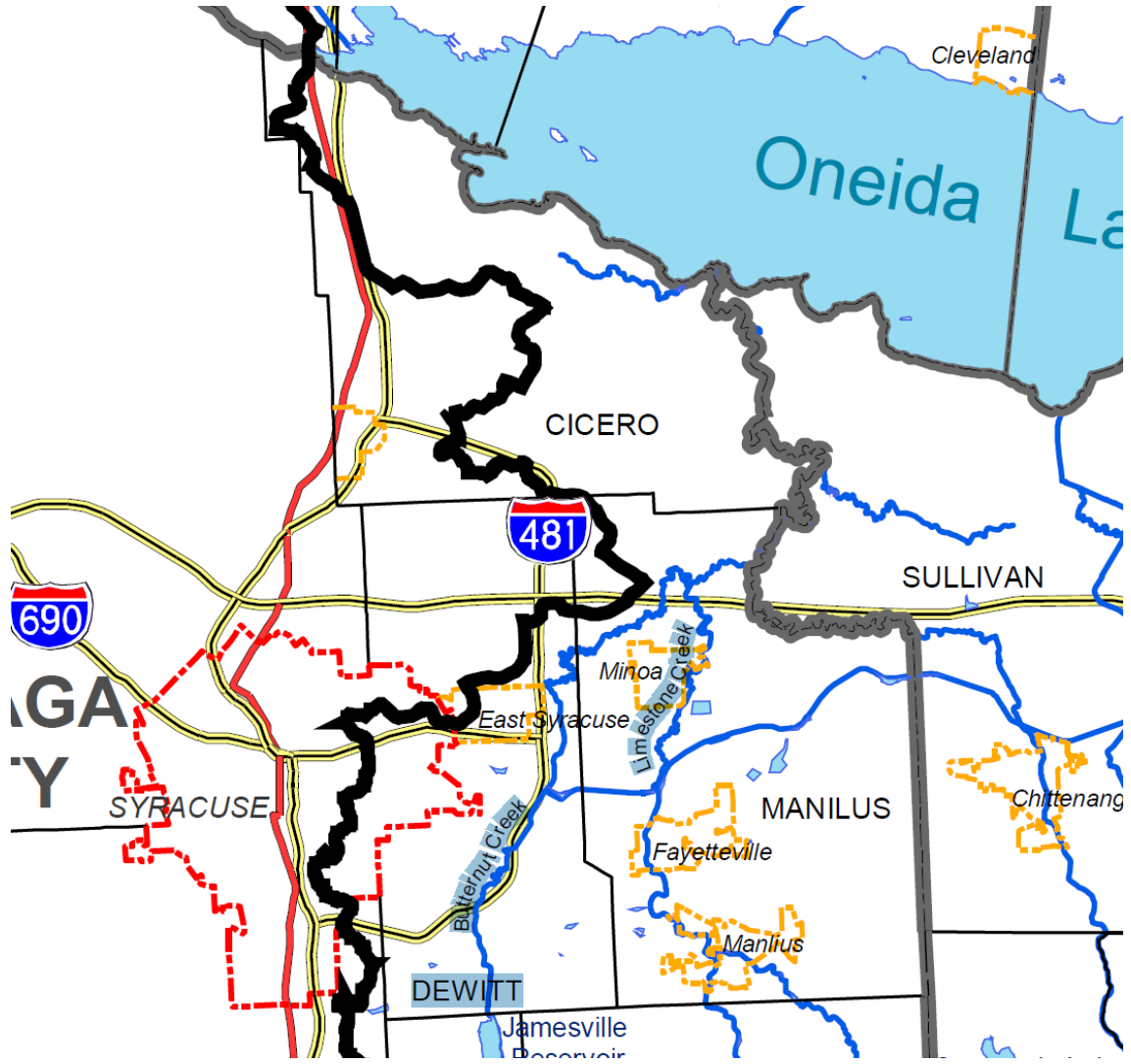

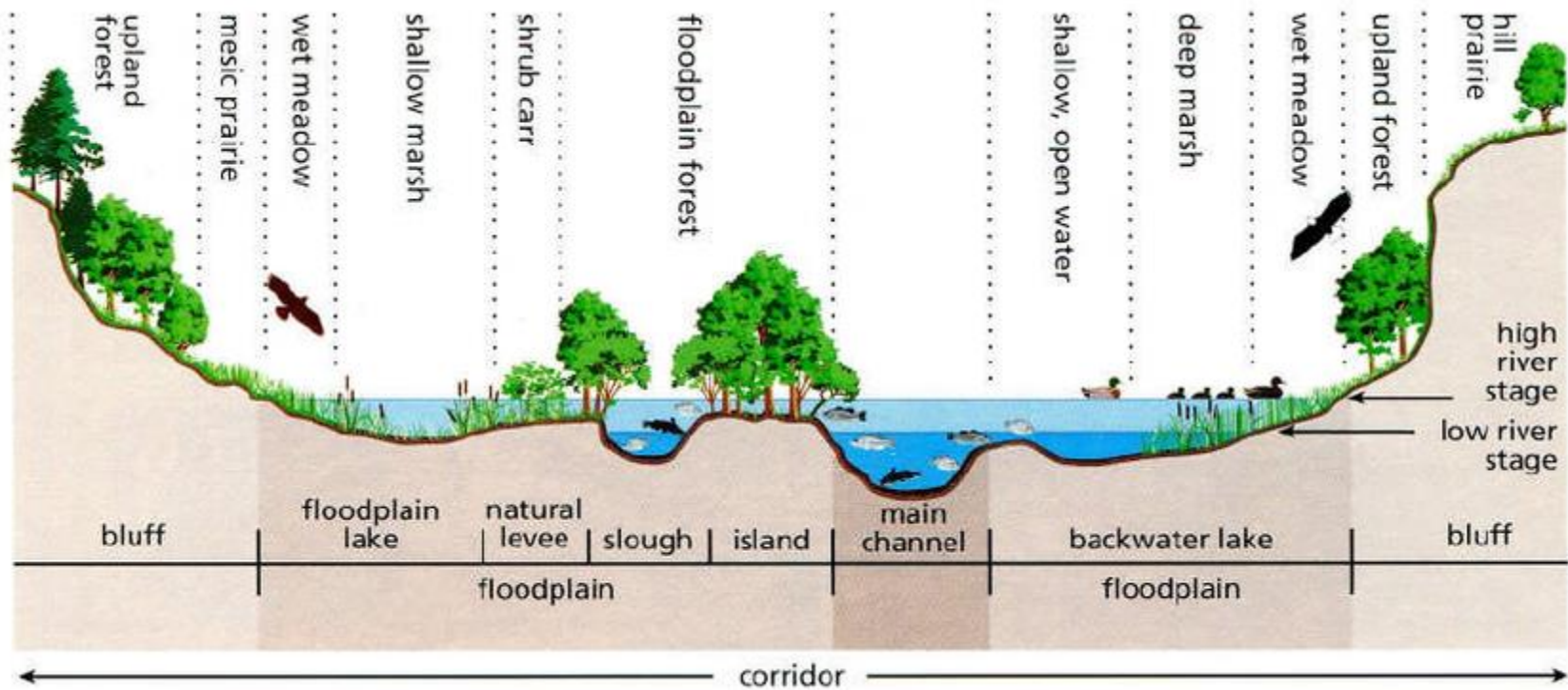
# Quality of Life includes...

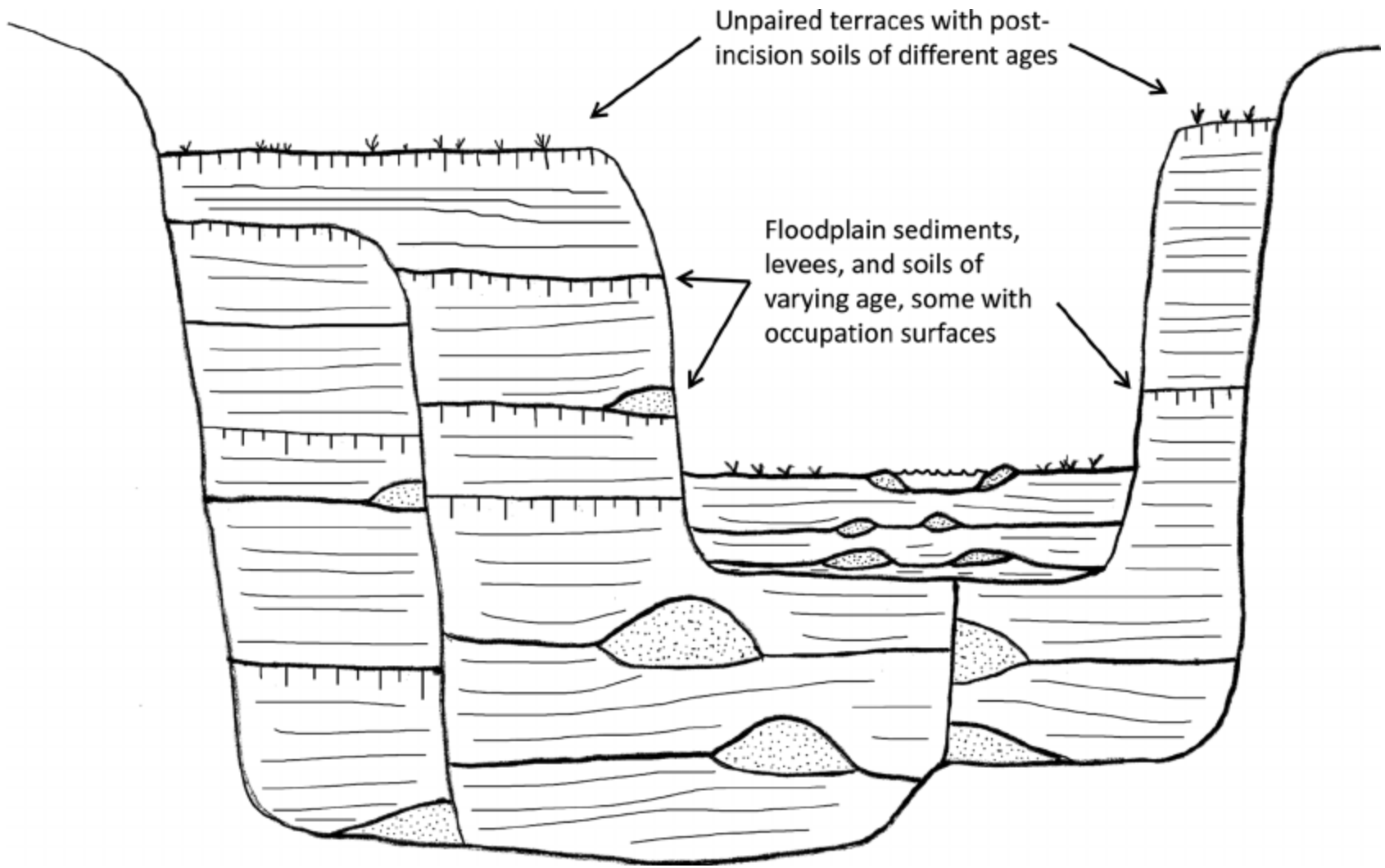
- Recreation activities
